## Our Uniform

- Studs or sleepers
- Small scrunchies


## What Should Not Be Worn

- Denim
- Short Clothing
- Jewellery
- High Heels
- Make-up
- Tank Tops
- Glitter
- Tattoos
- Board shorts
- Thongs (Swimming only)


## Hair Styles

- Hair must be kept neat at all times and appropriate hair styles worn.
- Head lice are a problem in all schools and maintaining neat, well-kept hair can assist in managing this issue.
- Students wearing in appropriate hairstyles can be precluded from school photos.


## Expectations

- Parents will support the dress code
- Staff will support the dress code
- All students will wear the school uniform.
- Students on excursions or representing the school at carnivals will wear the school uniform.


## Following our Dress Code

- The school will follow up on dress code issues using both formal and informal processes as outlined below.
Informal - teachers discussing one-off dress issues with students.
Formal - students who repeatedly do not adhere to the dress code will report to administration, letter sent to parents seeking their support.


## If Dress Code is Not Followed

- Students may be required to exchange clothes for appropriate wear available from lost property or uniform shop.
- Students may be excluded from excursions, school photos, sporting events or other outings where they represent the school.


## Exemptions

- At the principal's discretion an exemption from wearing the uniform can be granted if sufficient reasons warrant this.
