This service is provided from the many fixed or mobile Dental Therapy Centres located mainly in primary schools. If you're not enrolled, it's not too late to enrol now.

You can continue to go to the same Dental Therapy Centre you went to in primary school or contact a new centre if you have moved. Remember that you are entitled to dental care with the School Dental Service and are most welcome to ring for an appointment.


