Safety Bay Primary School's Behaviour Management Approach

Some of you may have read the front page article entitled "Tough Love" in *The Weekend West* last Saturday. Our school's mission, goals, ethos and values reflect many of the key messages contained in this article and can be accessed on our website: www.safetybayps.wa.edu.au

Our school's behavior management approach is based on "Play is the Way" (formerly the "Game Factory"). Wilson McCaskill has written a book called "**Children Aren't Made of China**". I recommend this book to you as we continue to work together to support the social and emotional development of your child. We have a number of copies of this book in our school library. Please contact Ms Casey if you would like to borrow one of these books.

Our approach is designed to develop self-motivated, self-regulating, independent and resilient students who work hard to become life-long learners and love learning. Just as the article discussed I believe it is important that schools help students develop persistence and resilience. All students need to demonstrate self-respect and self-control. These qualities are very important in preparing our students for the future.

Our school rules are very simple:

- Follow all teachers' instructions
- Respect yourself and others
- Play and work safely
- Care for our school

We encourage our students to do the "right thing" because they believe it is the best thing to do rather than getting into trouble or because they will get something for it. Classroom teachers use these four rules to collaboratively develop their classroom rules. Students are familiar with these rules which encompass the values of our school:

- Respect;
- Responsibility;
- Resilience;
- Reflections and
- Relationships

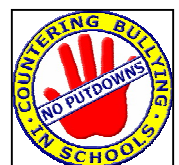
