- **QKR!** Download this App to your smart phone. It even enables electronic permissions!
- Direct deposit through internet banking
- EFTPOS at the office
- Credit Card at the office or by placing details on school payment envelopes

QkR! App and direct deposit through internet banking are the preferred options. These methods ensure there is a clear trail for all payments with lodgement receipts from your bank and payments may be processed in a time efficient manner. Additionally, QkR! App is paper free and another great reason to give it a go.
